Many thanks for the below email - ASAS is very interested in continuing our interactions and collaborations, especially in light of the success of the Quebec meeting. Unfortunately, we are booked through '05 and will be locking into '06 and '07 in the very near future. I am unsure what this might translate to in regard CSAS interest (based on locations) or to conference center space that will be available. For this reason, I've cc'd our meetings planners and conventions director as well as others who will be better able to answer at least the question of space, etc. I've also cc'd Brenda Carlson, ADSA Executive Director, as we have joint meetings planned with ADSA every year for the foreseeable future and Jim Kessler, PSA Executive Director, as we are planning more joint meetings with the Poultry Science group as well.

Here's what we have planned in the near future, and locations we are looking at a few years out:  
2003 Phoenix, AZ; jt with ADSA and AMPA (Mexican Association)  
2004 St Louis, MO; jt with ADSA and PSA  
2005 Cincinnati, OH; jt with ADSA (I assume this location would be of low interest?)  
Not yet locked in:  
2006 looking primarily at Minneapolis, MN (July 9-13; this might be a location of interest to CSAS)  
2007 looking at two locations in Texas - again, I assume this would be of low interest to CSAS.

Based on the above, would 2006 be of interest to begin discussions across all of our respective societies? I believe that PSA might already be locked into a site, but believe that it may be of interest in future years for all our groups to plan a meeting.

Thanks again Shannon, I believe your email will spark a great deal of discussion and the timing is excellent due to the ASAS and ADSA board meetings this month and PSA's board meeting in early July (if this is of interest to your group Jim).

Thoughts from the FASS group? I believe we should be in good position to make some adjustments (if any are needed) regarding the 2006 discussions.
