The Opportunity:

Two M.Sc. graduate students are sought to carry out research projects with full financial support in the areas of Feed Science, Ruminant Nutrition, and/or Feed Structure/Chemistry and Synchrotron Applications.

Qualifications:

The applicant should have a B.Sc degree in agriculture, animal science, or one of natural sciences related to the project. A commitment to pursue a research career, good communication and writing skills and the ability to work in a team environment are essential qualities. A successful application to the College of Graduate Studies at the University of Saskatchewan will be required. Stipend:

For the successful candidate, the standard rate for a University graduate stipend will be awarded \$16,500/year at the M.Sc. level. Plus an additional grant to fund research related activities, attendance at conference and publication of papers.

Preference is for two students to be in place by May 1, 2010 or no later than September 1, 2010.
